TDL AIMS TO HELP CHANGE LIVES

Star Sharks spearhead and former Sydney and St Kilda forward, Trent Dennis-Lane, is setting the example as a youth leader off the field.

Trent has just completed a 140-kilometre charity walk in Western Australia for the LifeChanger Foundation. LifeChanger is run by former AFL star and St Kilda coach Scott Watters, and aims to develop a positive self-identity in young Australians.

Trent, known as TDL to Sharks fans, was coached by Watters as a junior in the WAFL and became involved in the foundation after reconnecting with him when playing with Sandringham.

Trent took a fortnight off training to undertake the Cape-to-Cape trek in south west Western Australia with 20 other participants, raising over \$80,000. Among the high profile walkers were former Ironman Trevor Hendy, iron-woman and former stand-up-paddle-board world champion Karla Gilbert and Olympic swimming star Samantha Riley.

Trent said the trek from Cape Naturaliste Lighthouse to Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse was a test both physically and mentally, but well worth the effort.

"It was hard work and I was pretty knackered at the end. They were long days camping in tents and working together, but it was good to get away from everything and be off line," he said.

"We ran the group through a condensed program and concentrated on personal growth and development. It was a real success and raising the money we did was a great result."
